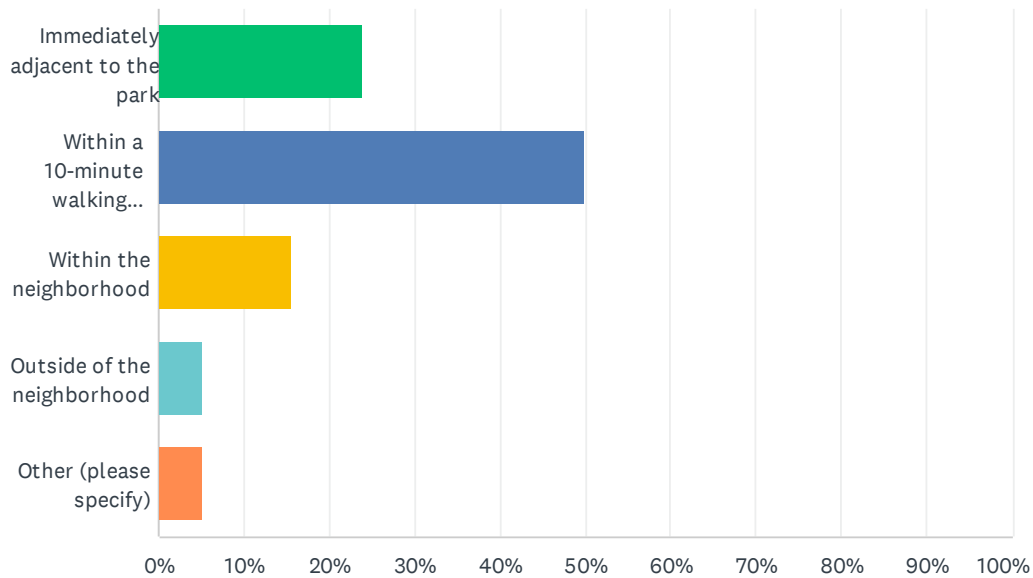


Q1 How far do you live from the park?

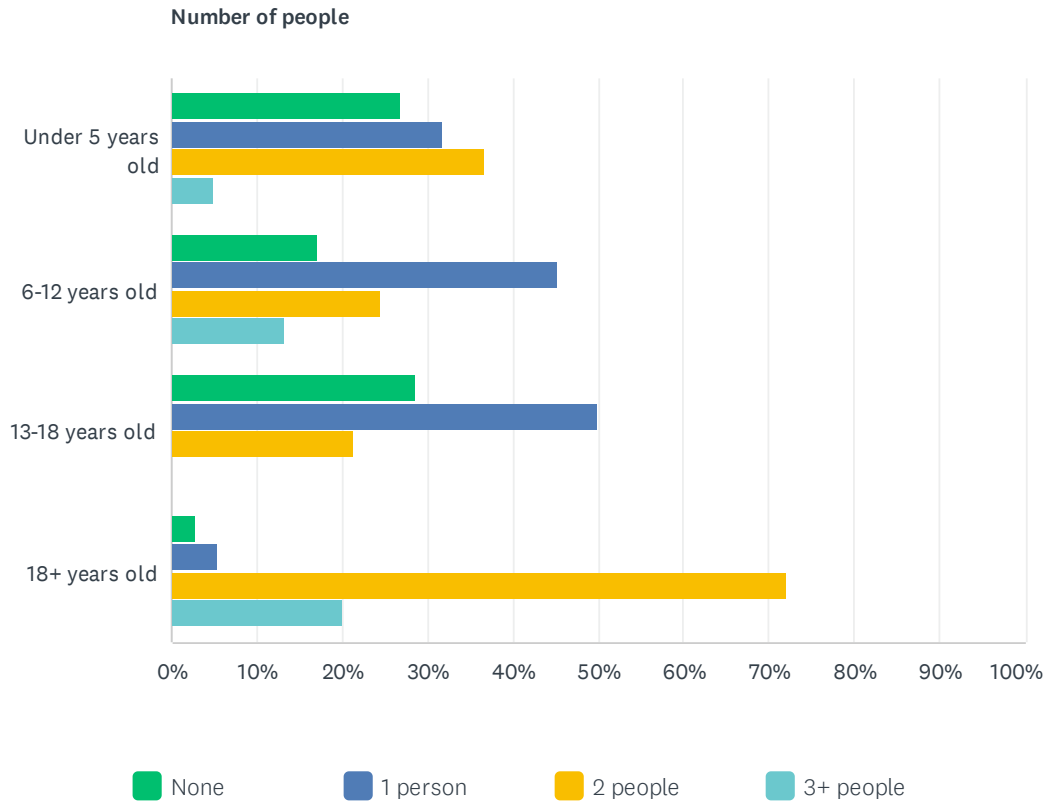

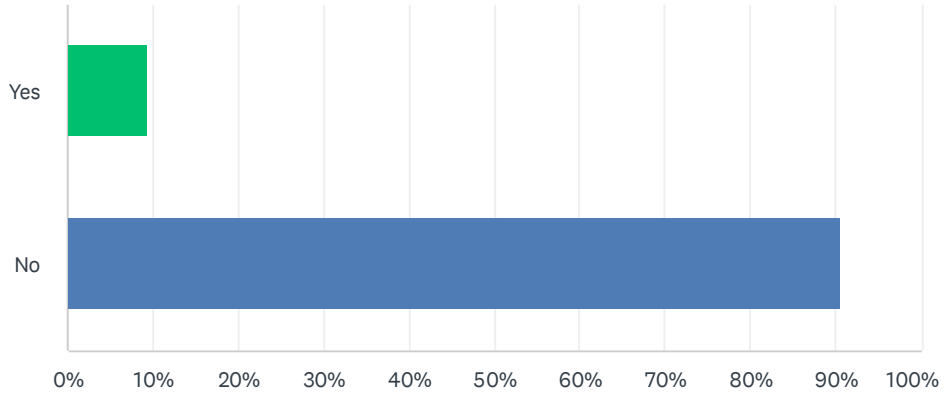

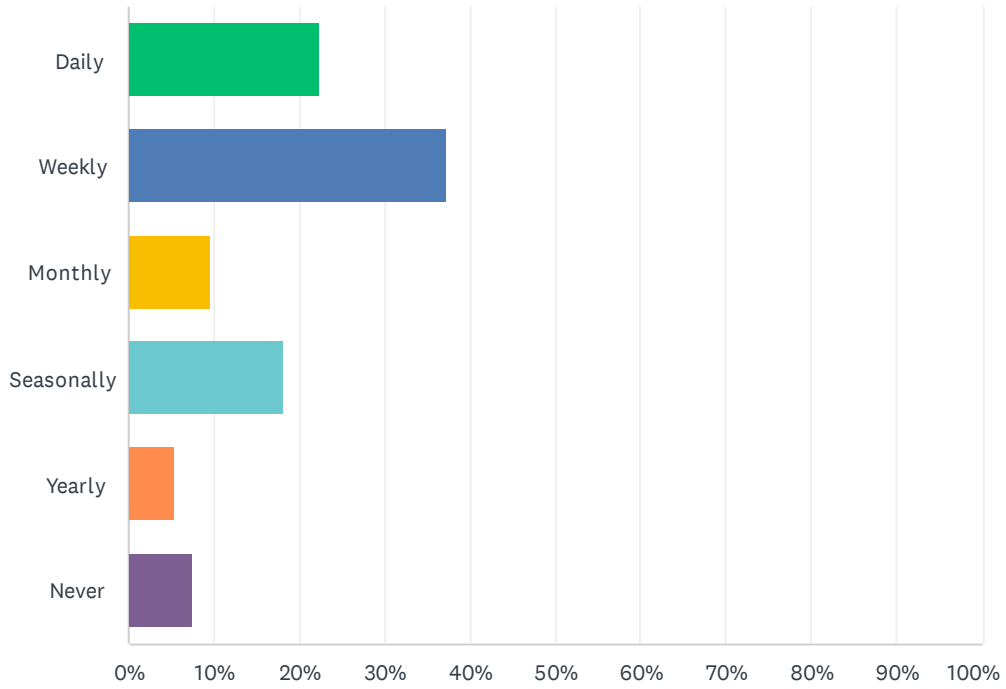

The trail is important to many who live nearby and even outside the neighborhood. Make sure it is worthwhile and not just an afterthought. It would be nice to connect to a sidewalk on Engler. There is currently only a sidewalk on one side of Engler, forcing you to cross the street. Q5 How often did you or members of your household visit Meadow Park?

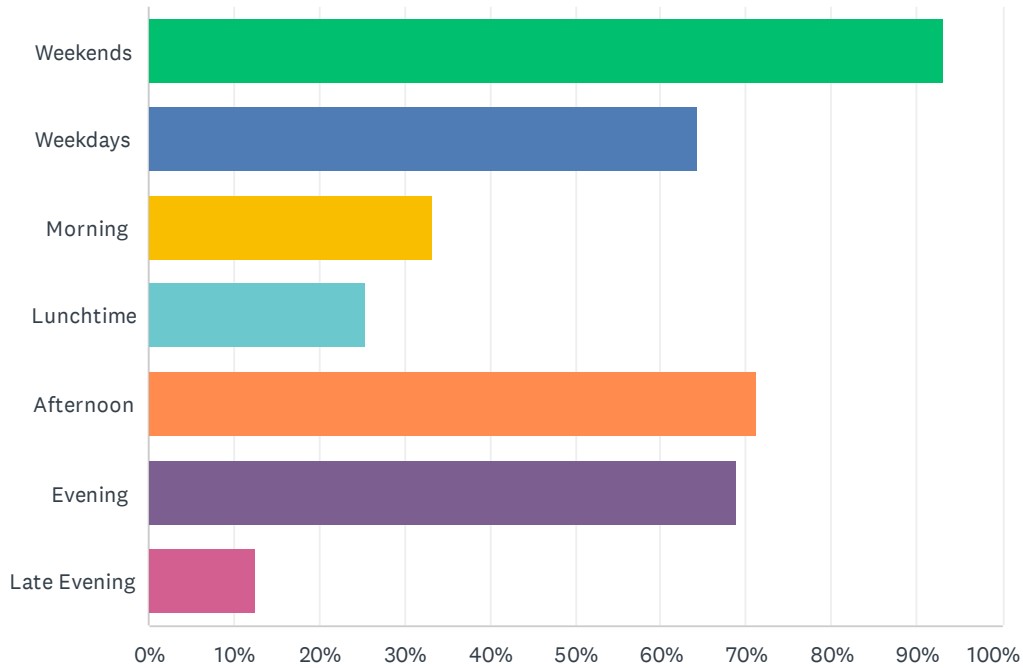

Q6 When would you or members of your household typically visit Meadow Park? (select all that apply)

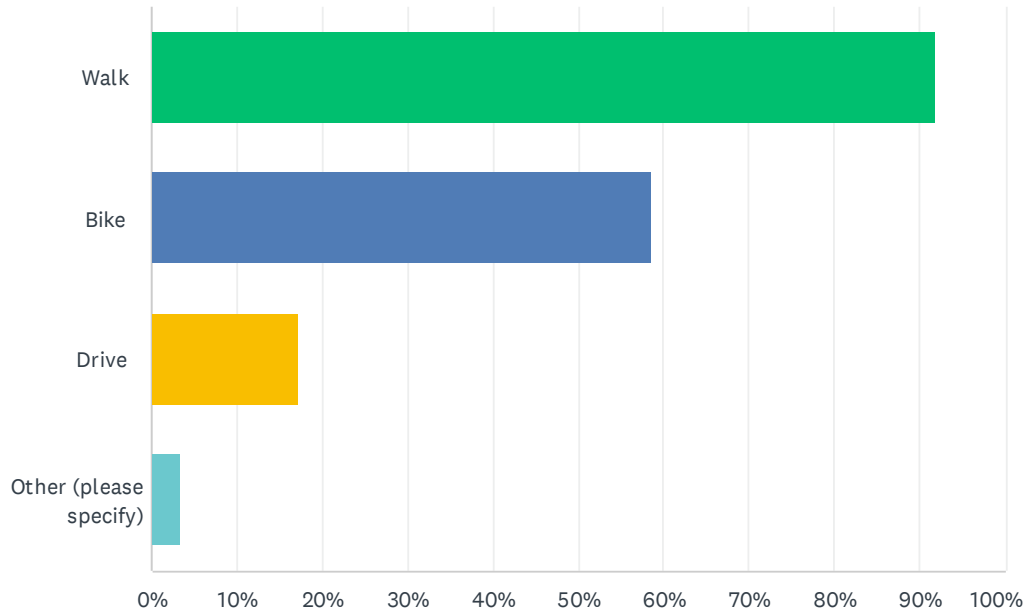

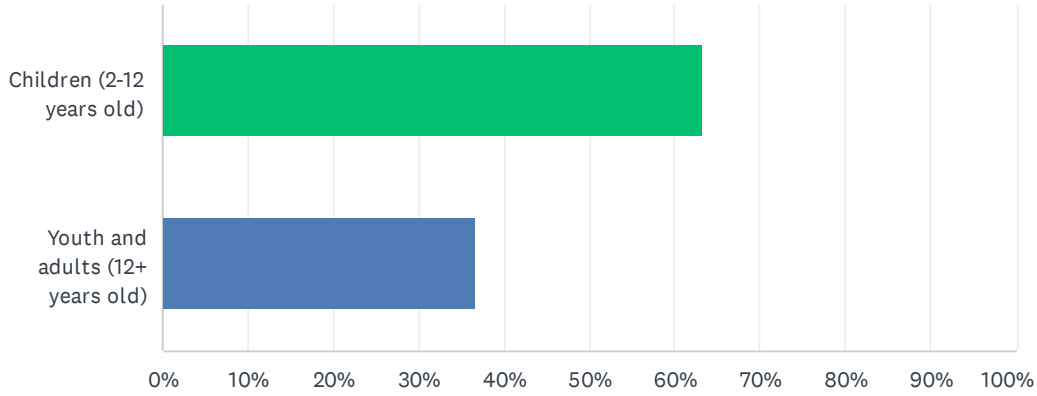

Q14 What age group should Meadow Park be designed for? (Typically, neighborhood parks are built for children 2-12 years old).

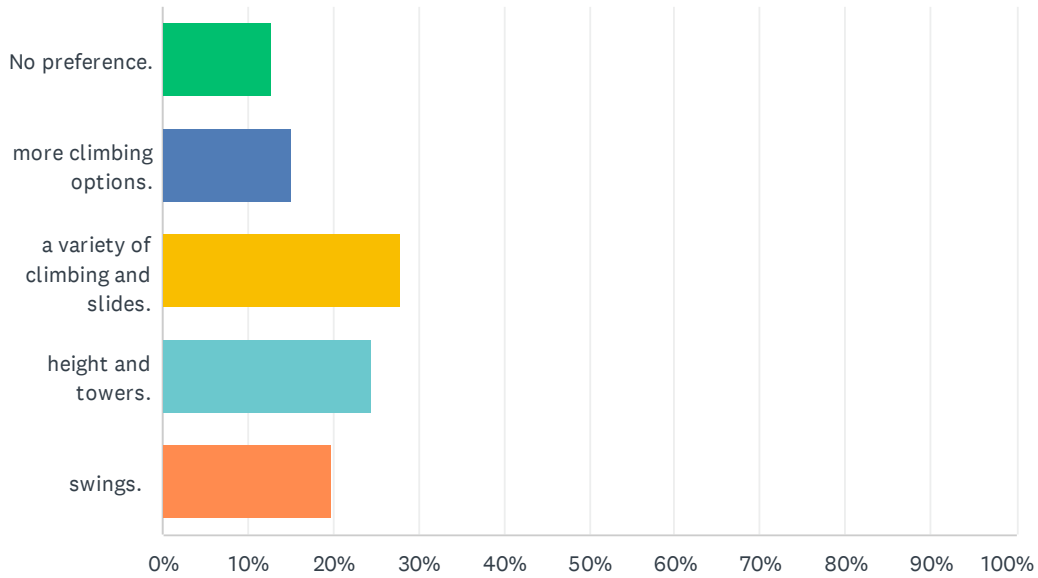

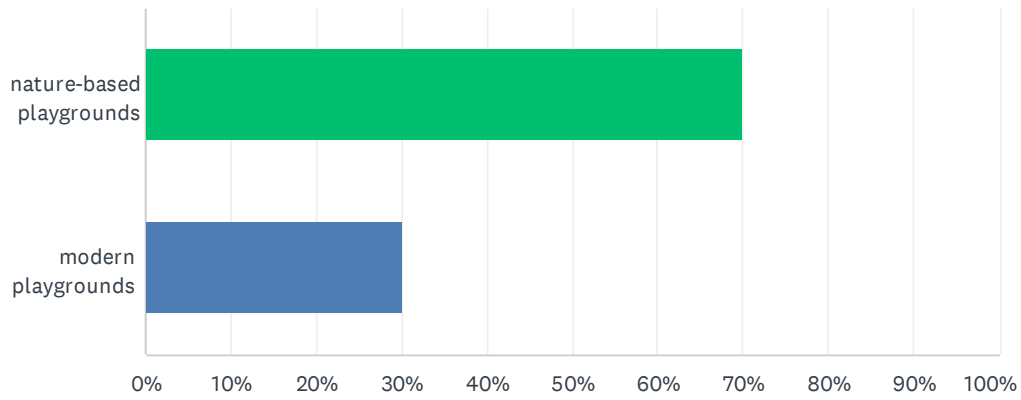

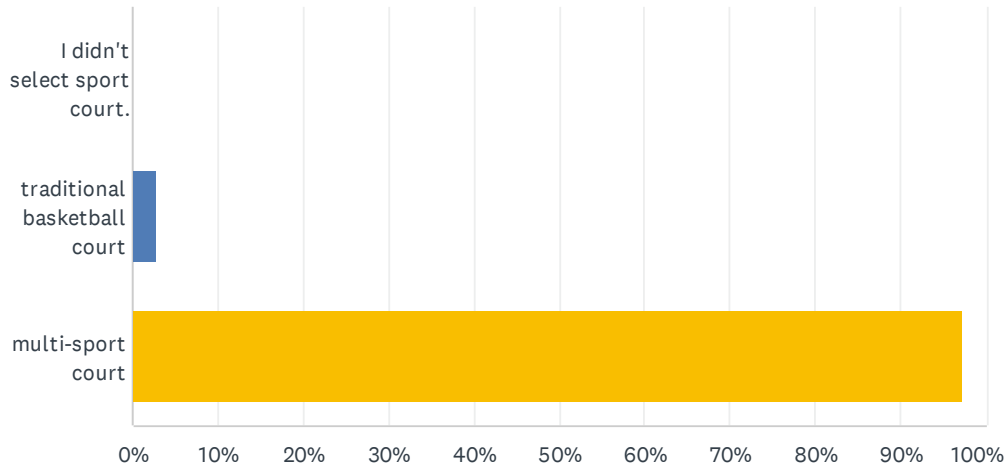

Q19 If you chose a sportcourt, which would you prefer?

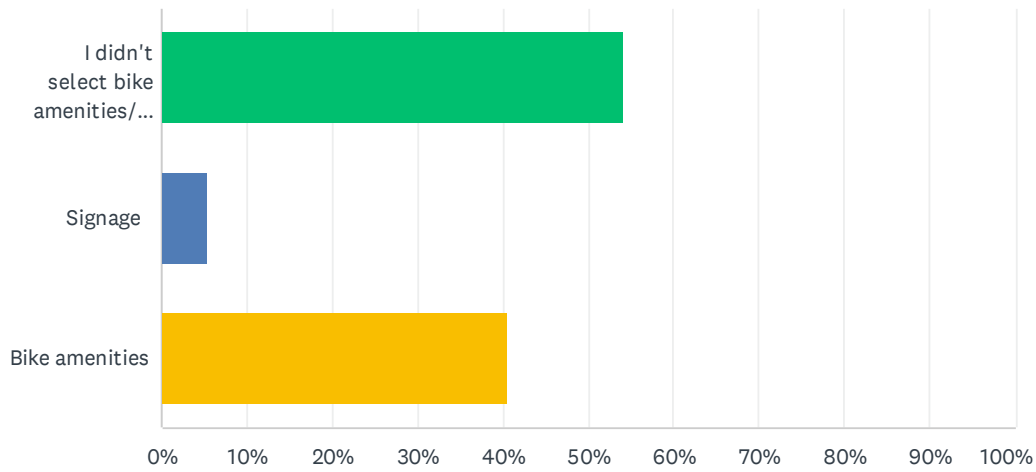

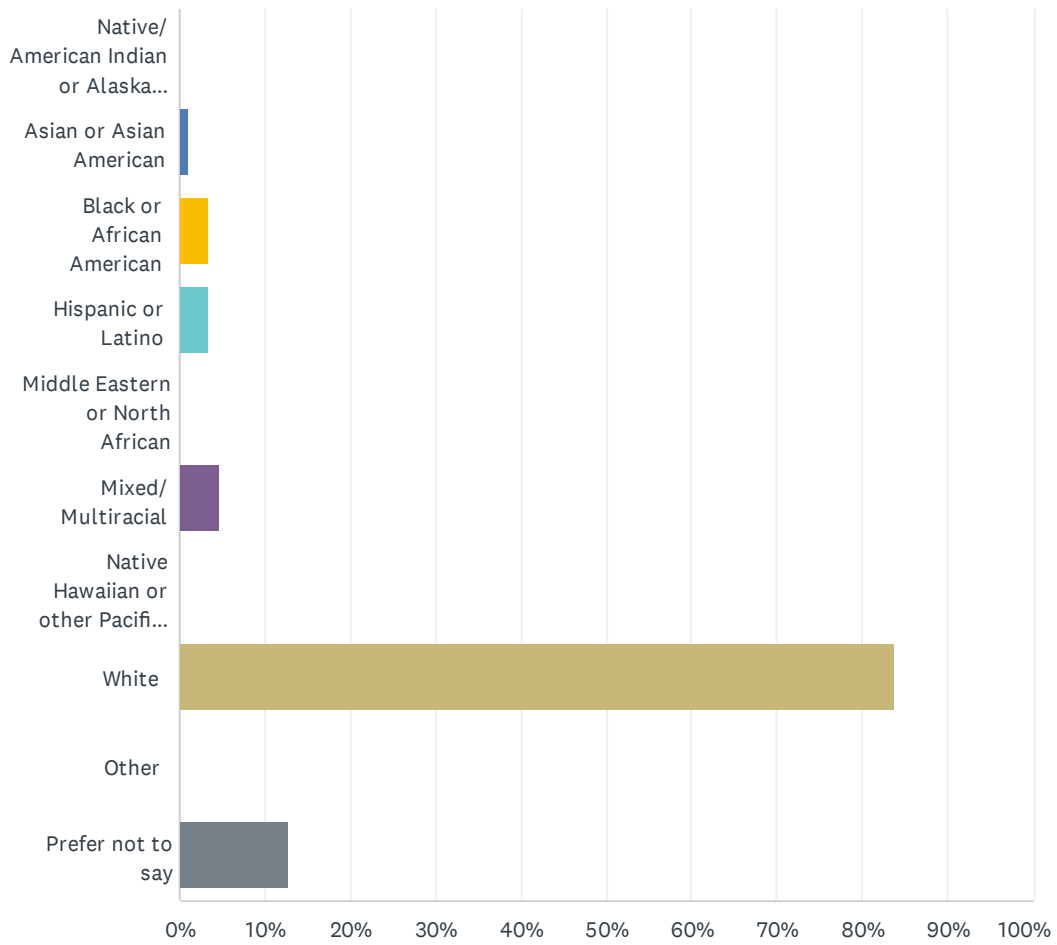

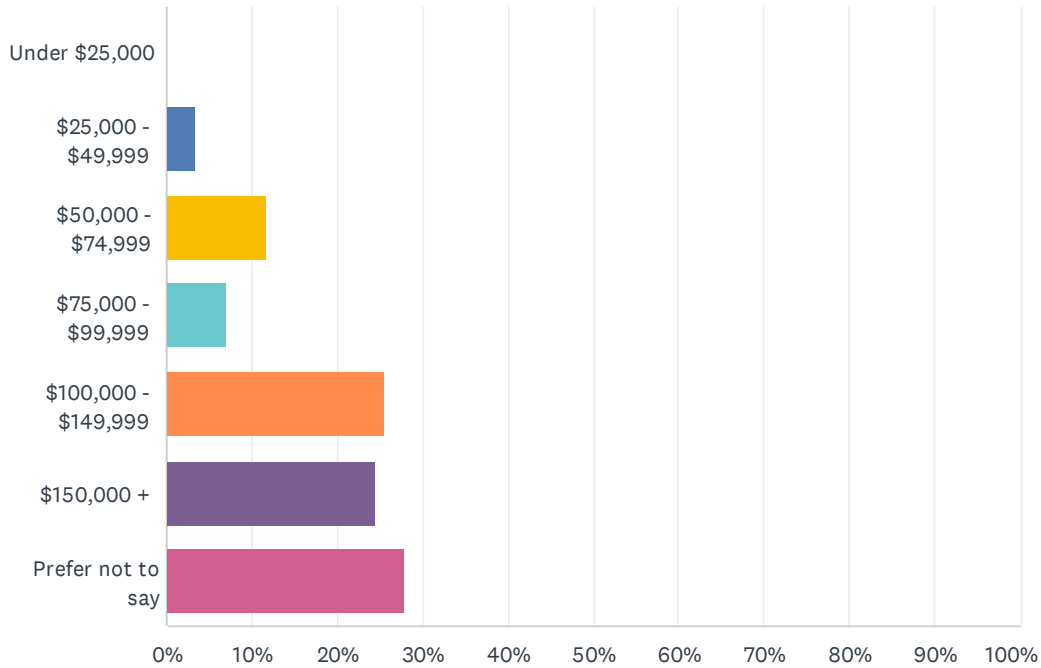
