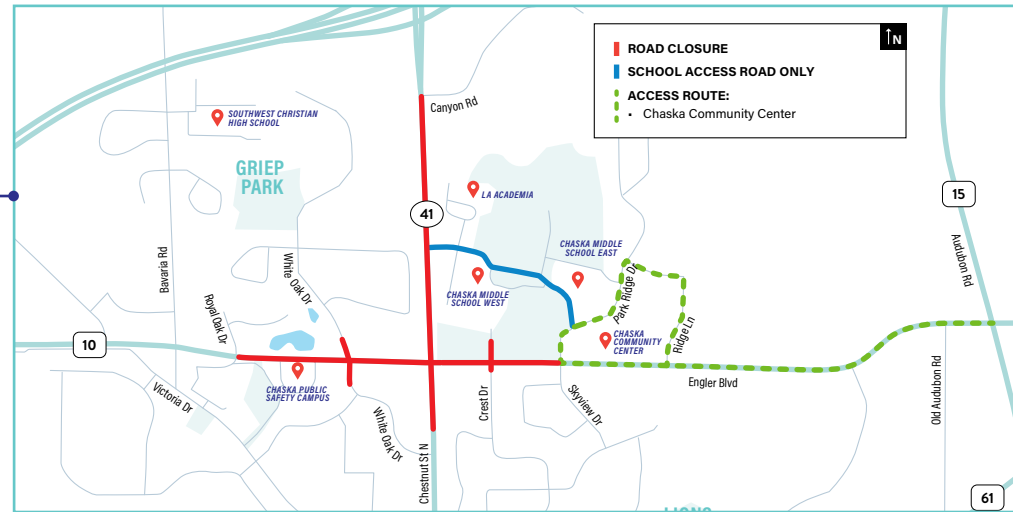


Highway 41/10 Project

Carver County is making key improvements to Highway 10 (Engler Boulevard) between Highway 212 and Old Audubon Road in Chaska. Among the many enhancements includes the addition of roundabouts at Bavaria Road, White Oak Drive, Highway 41 (Chestnut Street) and Park Ridge Drive. The first roundabout, at Bavaria Road, is complete. Roundabouts at White Oak Drive and Highway 41 (Chestnut Street) are anticipated to be completed late summer. Park Ridge Drive roundabout is anticipated to begin late summer and be completed late fall.

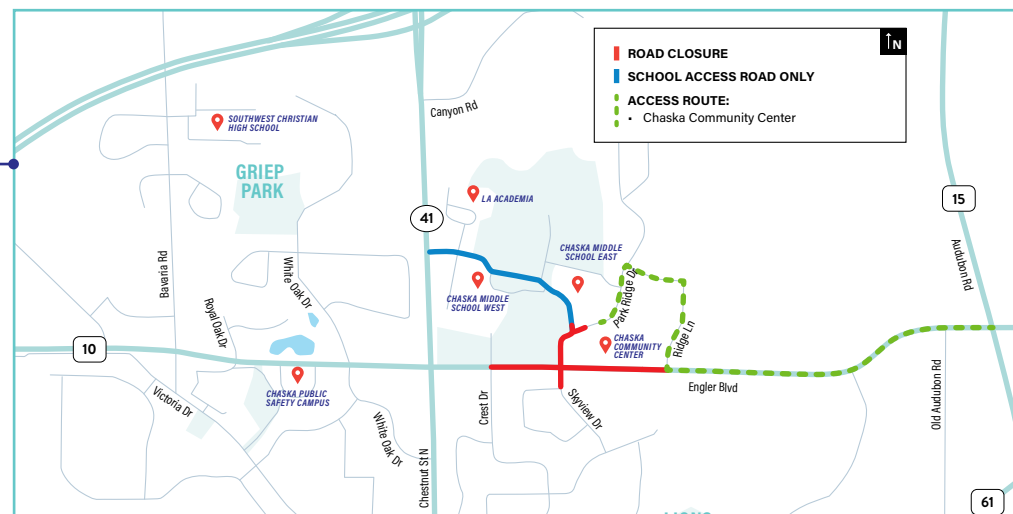
Community Center Access Map During Closures at Highway 41 and White Oak Drive

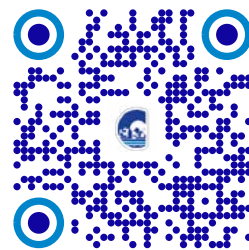

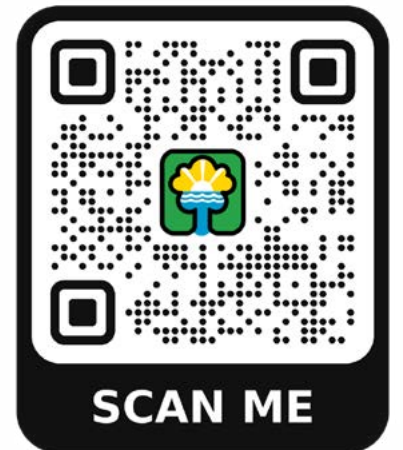
